ESTIMATED NUMBERS

Each year the festival continues to grow in numbers and exhibitors and we anticipate that for this year as well. The majority of attendees come from Wallowa and Union Counties, but we also have families join us from all over the Pacific Northwest. Typically, there are 500-700 people in attendance.

DETAILS

- The cost to participate is FREE!
- Every exhibitor must have a family-oriented activity and an organization sign at their booth.
- During setup and take down, participants can bring vehicles onto the fairgrounds. During the festival, vehicles need to be moved near the OSU extension office.
- Items past participants found useful for their booth: sun shade, tables, chairs, tape, stapler, sharpie, canopy/tent weight bags for stability and wind. Note: you must supply all of your materials, including tables, tents, and chairs.
- Free hot dog, chips, and a drink for kids
- The Maxville Heritage Interpretive Center will also be offering a home cooked FUNDRAISER meal!
